BATTERIES

Lithium Batteries are commonly found in cellphones, laptops, e-cigarettes, digital cameras, electric cars, table saws, etc. Lithium Batteries should be disposed of at a local Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Day. Alkaline Batteries can be disposed of in your household trash. These batteries are non-hazardous.

Lead-acid Batteries are commonly found in automobiles, power tools, and backup generators. Lead-acid Batteries should be disposed of at your local Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Day.

LATEX (or water-based) PAINT

Unlike oil-based paint, latex is non-hazardous. To prepare your latex paint for household trash disposal, dry it out with kitty litter or speedy dry. In addition, latex paint can be donated to your local Habitats for Humanity or other non-profit organizations.

WHITE GOODS

"White goods", or items with refrigerant, are items such as air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc. These can be disposed of through your local municipality or at the Solid Waste Complex for a small fee.

FLUORESCENT BULBS

Unlike other bulbs, fluorescent bulbs contain mercury. Fluorescent bulbs should be disposed of at your local Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Day.


