Dear Mr. Velazquez:

The Bureau of Planning & Licensing is in receipt of an administrative action to the Cumberland County District Solid Waste Management Plan ("County Plan"), dated October 26, 2021. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of the New Leaf, LLC ("New Leaf") Class A facility to operate and process a maximum daily capacity of 130 tons per day of single stream Class A materials (paper, cardboard, #1 & #2 plastics, aluminum, glass, and tin) at The Authority's former Material Recovery Facility ("MRF") located on Block 76, Lot 14 in Deerfield Township.

The published scale hours are Monday-Friday 7:30am-3:30pm, Saturday 8am-12pm. New Leaf will operate simultaneously with the scale receiving materials at these times. The production time processing the materials, meetings, maintenance, holiday surges, downtime, etc. will be those same days (Monday-Saturday) but on a 5am-11pm schedule. A single shift 7am-4pm may not keep up with daily demands and additional shifts would be added as needed within that 5am-11pm schedule.

Pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(b) 3, the inclusion of new recycling facilities for processing Class A recyclable materials can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of New Leaf to operate a Class A at the former MRF facility, is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(f).
