

Starting May 4, 2022 NJ Law will ban all stores and food service businesses from providing plastic bags to reduce litter. Don't wait! Start bringing reusable bags now.



## BAG UP NJ



Effective May 4, 2022, NJ Law will ban single-use plastic bags at all retail stores, food service businesses and grocery stores, as well as paper bags at grocery stores at or larger than 2,500 square feet. The law also bans food service businesses from providing polystyrene foam food products.

As of **November 4**, 2021, *plastic straws* will only be available upon a customer's request.
