What's New at The Authority?

Millville Library Update

The new addition to the Millville Public Library is moving forward. We are under roof and the carpenters, masons, and window installers are working hard to enclose the rest of the building envelope.

Rowan Medicine Building Update

The Rowan Medicine Building continues to progress with all structural steel and roof decking installed. Next is the exterior wall framing, sheathing, and masonry work followed by interior wall framing. Rowan Medicine is projected for completion in April of 2024 and is currently on track to finish ahead of schedule.

RCSJ Maintenance Storage Building

The new RCSJ Maintenance Storage Building is a 2,400 SF, 40' x 60' x 14' high pole barn located at the north end of campus behind the Alampi Science Building and MILL Building adjacent to Rt. 55. The new building will be used to house equipment and materials that no longer fit in the existing storage buildings. At the request of the City of Millville, all rainwater from the rooftop is being diverted to a new rain garden north of the project site, which will also collect roof runoff from the existing MILL Building. Construction began in February and is scheduled to be complete by the middle of April.

Upper Deerfield Shared Service Pole Barn

The existing Upper Deerfield Township Convenience Center, a recycling facility, was recently destroyed by fire. Through a shared services agreement with Upper Deerfield Township, The Authority will construct a replacement pre-engineered wood building (pole barn) that matches the size and footprint of the existing building at 50' x 84' x 15' high, or 4,200 SF. The building will be used to store recyclable white goods, electronics, and other materials that need to be kept free of weather. The plans also include constructing a break room, toilet room, and utility room inside the building in the same location and approximately the same size as the original facilities. Materials will be delivered to the site in April. Framing of the building will commence shortly after materials are delivered. We expect the building will be complete by early May.

The Authority Hosts Record-Breaking Trash Hunt

Every March, the Cumberland County Clean Communities Program hosts a county-wide Trash Hunt to promote awareness and accountability for preserving the environment. The Authority's Clean Communities program provided gloves, trash bags, and trash pickup after the event to ensure proper disposal. A total of 19.06 tons (38,120 pounds) of waste and 4.46 tons (8,920 pounds) of tires were removed from various locations throughout Cumberland County. All trash was properly disposed of at The Authority's Solid Waste Complex.
