## What's New at The Authority?

### Millville Library Update

The new addition to the Millville Public Library continues to progress on schedule. Masonry and cladding have continued. The curtainwall installation is complete. The construction team is looking forward to completion of the storefront windows and glass to finalize the addition envelope.

### Rowan Medicine Building Update

The Rowan Medicine Building construction is progressing ahead of schedule. Exterior sheathing is complete and interior wall framing is underway. HVAC ductwork and fire sprinklers are being installed. The new roof will be complete by mid-May.

### Tank Upgrades

To the right, is a rare view of the inside of the Authority's Bio-Tank. Typically, this tank holds 418,000 gallons of leachate. Recently, the tank was emptied and cleaned by the Authority's staff for inspection and repairs. This was no small job, as there was approximately two feet of sludge on the bottom that needed to be removed. The inspection went well and the tank is back on-line. The pipes seen in the picture are used to aerate the tank during normal operation and help the bio-mass thrive.

### Upper Deerfield Shared Service Pole Barn

The Upper Deerfield Township Convenience Center has been framed, enclosed, and the underground rough-ins are complete. Upper Deerfield Township will pour the concrete slab-on-grade on May 13. Construction of the break room, bathroom, and the installation of the overhead doors will begin following the completion of the concrete slab. The Upper Deerfield Pole Barn is expected to be complete by the end of May.
