What's New at The Authority?

Millville Library

The Millville Library project continues with renovations to the existing library building. All demolition has been completed and the roof has been replaced. Asbestos abatement in the basement and on the first floor is expected to be completed in early January, followed by all new HVAC ductwork, electric, plumbing, and framing.





Solid Waste Complex Side Slope & Administration Building Berm and Trees

Atlantic Lining Co. has completed the Side Slope Enhancement Project at the Solid Waste Complex. All covered cells of the landfill now have wind defender on the slopes. The wind defender installation has proven to be a tremendous addition, as there was no damage to the landfill rain cover during the recent storms. The Administration Building berm and tree installation was completed on December 15, 2023. Team Reed installed 42 trees on the berm, purchased locally at County Line Nursery.



New Jersey State Police Barracks

The Authority will be going out to bid this month for the New Jersey State Police Barracks project. Land acquisition and the subdivision of property are currently being processed. A plan review with the Treasury and New Jersey State Police was performed on December 21. where minor revisions were made.

Rowan Medicine Building

The Rowan Medicine building project continues with interior fit outs of casework and countertops. The main switchgear is expected to arrive in mid-January, which will allow for the completion of the interior finishes. The emergency generator has arrived and is being prepared for testing once the main switchgear is completed.


