What's New at The Authority?

Rowan Medicine Building

The Rowan Medicine Building is almost complete. The Temporary Certificate of Occupancy (TCO) is expected mid-May. Exterior signage has been installed. Interior finishes including flooring, final paint, doors, and hardware continue to progress. Final inspections are scheduled for the end of April. Medical equipment and furniture is scheduled to be delivered in May.



Cape May Library

The Cape May Library project is in the final stage and permission has been requested to begin building furniture. The remaining wood trim installation and completion of the new circulation desk are in progress. The wood floor for the main reading room is installed, stained, and clear-coated. The other floor finishes and the glass railing surrounding the mezzanine are nearing completion. Final inspections are being scheduled and completed within the next two weeks. The date for the ribbon cutting is being determined.



Millville Library

Renovations to the existing library are progressing. Interior framing and electrical and plumbing work continue to progress ahead of the drywall installation, which is expected to start in early April. The new interior metal staircase is nearing completion as well. All ductwork, rough electric, and plumbing are complete. The new elevator is expected to be installed in April. The new roof, copings, and downspouts are complete. The new brick facade on the Buck Street side of the library is also nearing completion. The Temporary Certificate of Occupancy (TCO) and furniture delivery are expected in May.



Cumberland Family Shelter - Building 3

A full renovation of a roughly 4,500 square-foot building is nearing completion and will soon be used for temporary housing for families. The building has seven sleeping units with two units that are handicap accessible. Each sleeping unit features a private bathroom with toilet and shower, kitchenette area with sink, refrigerator, and microwave. Resilient materials such as epoxy floors and PVC wall panels are used in the bathrooms and vinyl plank flooring in the remainder of the building will help keep the building clean and reduce contamination. The building also has four offices, a computer room for clients, and a multi-purpose room. A punch list walk through has been completed and the final completion date is set for June 2024.
