Broad Band

The Broadband Project is a joint application between Cumberland and Salem Counties for "Middle Mile" fiber optic loops to increase broadband availability in unserved and underserved areas. It will also provide better service to existing customers when the "last mile" is complete. The "middle mile" loops are expected to improve internet and other data connectivity services for county and municipal agencies.


